Art and Design - VÄRE

Tour in Väre, the newest Aalto University building for the School of Art, Design, and Architecture. The building is a vibrant space for dynamic encounters in Otaniemi Campus inaugurated in September 2018. The School produces world-class research in art education, design and design thinking, digital media and visual culture, urban planning and architecture. Architectural tour

Otaniemi is a crown jewel of Finnish architecture. A parkland-style campus established in the 1950s forms the core of Otaniemi. The overall vision of the campus was that of Alvar Aalto, and its individual buildings were designed by Aalto and other celebrated Finnish architects such as Reima and Raili Pietilä and Heikki and Kaija Sirén. Research of biomaterials - Ioncell technology

Ioncell is a sustainable technology that turns wood pulp and used textiles into new textile fibers avoiding harmful chemicals. The process shows great potential for the recycling of textile waste, as it can convert cotton waste into soft (feeling) but strong, high-quality fibers. The Independence Day evening gown was produced in collaboration with the School of Arts, Design and Architecture for Mrs. Jenni Haukio, the First Lady of Finland. Birch based ioncell fibers were used to produce the fabric. Several textiles are produced in cooperation with the Finnish Design house Marimekko and Aalto University design students. Ioncell fibers are researched at the School of Chemical Engineering. More information at [website](#).

Ice Tank

Aalto University plays a leading role in Arctic technology research and education. The basin has wave makers that allow research on problems related to ice and waves. The basin is equipped with a cooling

system and equipment to produce model-scale sea ice. Typical experiments in the tank include resistance, propulsion, and maneuvering tests of ships in ice, tests on ice loads on marine structures and modelling of natural ice formations, such as ice ridges. The facility also enables a wide range of other experiments on the physical phenomena related to sea ice. Aalto Ice Tank is unique in Europe, multifunctional and used for open water tests as well.
