How to apply?

- Application period: 7.-20.1.2021
 - Applications are sent through Studyinfo
 - There are two separate Admission Groups with different criteria
- Results to be published at latest:
 4.6.2021
 - You can only accept one study place leading to a higher education degree for studies starting in autumn 2021
- Studies start in September 2021





How to apply: Admission Group I

- For applicants who
 - complete the Finnish matriculation examination, IB, EB or DIA/RP degree in spring 2021 at the latest and
 - pass the advanced mathematics test of the matriculation examination (or equivalent IB/EB/RP/DIA)
- Admission is based on the grades of Finnish matriculation examination, IB, EB or DIA/RP degrees
- Applicants are also required to meet the minimum requirements set by the study options



How to apply: Admission Group I

Minimum grade requirements in the matriculation examination

Study option	Mathematics (advanced)	Physics
Chemical Engineering	E	-
Computational Engineering	E	-
Data Science	E	-
Digital Systems and Design	E	-
Quantum Technology*	L	E

*In the study option Quantum Technology, only one of the set requirements (mathematics or physics) must be met.

How to apply: Admission Group II

- For applicants who complete a secondary school degree in spring 2021 at the latest
- Admission is based on SAT test results
- All applicants must complete the following tests:
 - SAT test (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing + Mathematics sections), minimum score 1200
 - SAT subject test in mathematics (Mathematics level 1 or level 2), minimum score 650
- Applicants are ranked based on the score of the SAT test (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing + Mathematics sections)



How to apply: Admission Group II

- SAT tests must be completed by 13 March 2021 at the latest
 - SAT subject test can not be completed on the same test date as the SAT test, and SAT subject tests are not offered in March 2021
 - SAT subject test must be completed by 5 Dec 2020 at the latest
 - SAT test must be completed by 13 March 2021 at the latest
- Test results must be received by Aalto University by 20 Apr 2021 at the latest
