

The Finnish University Partnership for International Development - UniPID, is a network of Finnish universities. It was established in 2002 by university rectors who were aiming to advance universities' global responsibility.

Currently, nine Finnish universities are members of the network. In addition three institutions act as observer members: National Union of University Students in Finland SYL, Unu-WIDER and The Finnish Society for Development Research FSDR.



UniPID supports higher education institutions in bringing global responsibility and Global South perspectives into their education, research, and societal impact activities, thus promoting international partnerships in support of sustainable development pathways.

In this sense, UniPID offers services in the three pillars of higher education: Research, Societal Impact and Education

Education Pillar Vision

UniPID Virtual Studies Programme



UniPID Virtual Studies consist of online courses provided by UniPID Member Universities, giving students access to specialized training and expertise from other Finnish universities. Topics covered include, but are not limited to, development, education, gender, human rights, health, economics, trade, governance, rule of law, environment, sustainability, climate change, conflicts, decolonialism, migration, extractivism, and social movements.

Students from the UniPID Member Universities, including exchange students, are offered the opportunity to take courses offered by the different Member Universities in their respective fields of specialization.

All courses are held in English and are worth 5 ECTS. Courses are free of charge for students enrolled in UniPID member universities. From 2020 onwards, some of the courses are organized in collaboration with partner universities from the Global South, in which case the courses are available and free also for their students. Some courses can also admit other students, at the discretion of the course teacher.

The UniPID Virtual Studies courses are designed to support the students' degree studies at their home universities, and it is also possible to compile them into a study module, 'Sustainability in Development', of at least 25 ECTS credits.






Please note that registration does not guarantee admission. Sometimes there are no seats for all the interested students
