2.2 Minor studies

If there is a mark "**Not confirmed**" in the minor. **You have to confirm the minor in the old Structure of Studies page → change it from the top of the page.**

You can confirm the minor to your study right by clicking the heading and then in the selection window "Selection requires confirmation". If you see "**No study right**" it means there is a separate application required for the minor.

2.3 Exchange studies abroad

If you complete exchange studies abroad, this will be your international minor.

1. Click the three dots next to Minors
2. Select or search for the international minor with code 'INTM-BIZ'.
3. Click the three dots next to the international minor and select 'Add a study draft'.

Study draft: name can be "Exchange studies" and planned credits are 24 ECTS for International Business and up to 30 ECTS for Economics.

You do not need to know your exchange destination yet. You can simply write "University abroad" as this is only a draft.

Finally, remember to send the Minors section for approval. After completing your exchange studies abroad, you must apply for a credit transfer on [page 28](#).

2.5 Language studies – Language Exemptions

If the language of your secondary education is other than Finnish or Swedish, you must apply for an exemption.

You can find the exemption form in [the student guide](#). Once completed, send the form to your programme's Planning Officer. You can also find more detailed information about the exemption criteria in the [student guide](#).

Once your exemption has been approved, choose at least 2 credits under the section "Second national language" using the free edit mode [p. 20](#). Search for the alternative course and save it to your PSP. Apply for approval using the instructions on [p. 19](#).

Keep in mind that the alternative course must be a language course, for example, Spanish 1.

INSTRUCTIONS

According to the Government Decree on University Degrees, students are required to demonstrate proficiency in both national languages, meaning Finnish and Swedish, in a higher education degree in Finland. The proficiency in your language of education (*koulusivistyskieli*) is demonstrated with a maturity essay written with the bachelor's thesis and proficiency in one of Finland's second national languages, which is demonstrated by passing a written and an oral test.

3.1 Applying for approval for sections

To apply for approval, use the **old structure of studies**:

- a) Click the heading of the section that says "approval required"
- b) Select free edit mode from the three dots.
- c) Click "apply for module content approval".
- d) Fill in the form and submit.

The request is directed to the planning officer of your programme. If you don't get the approval in 3 weeks, you can contact the planning officer by e-mail. At the beginning of autumn, there might be a longer delay.

3.2 Free edit mode and applying approval for exceptions

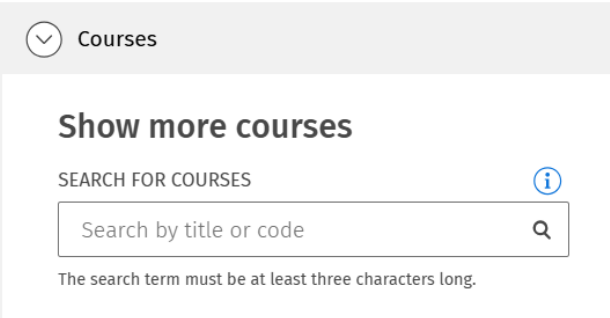
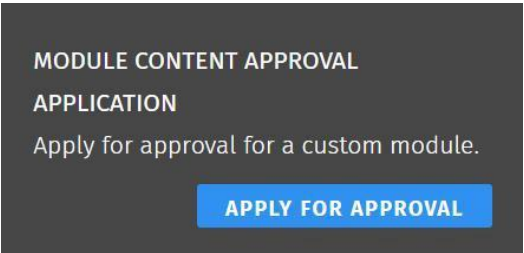
In free edit mode, you can:

- Add or remove courses in the structure.
- Apply for approval for an exception.

Note! You cannot edit the structure freely, but there always has to be a reason for it (for example, changes in the curriculum).

Free edit mode:

1. Open the section you want to edit and, in the window, select "Free edit mode" from the three dots.
2. You can search for courses, study modules, or add a study draft from here. It will also show a list of completed credits.
3. Using the **old structure of studies**, apply for approval.

3.3 Editing and applying for re-approval

If you want to change courses in a section which is already approved for you:

1. Click the three dots next to the heading that has status “selections approved.” In the window, click “Show application.”
2. At the bottom of the window, click “Relinquish the approval.”
3. Edit the courses again.
4. Apply for approval again; instructions on [page 19](#).

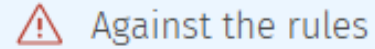

4.1 Against the rules sign



Selections against the rules -sign can occur for different reasons:

- You have chosen too many courses.
- You have added a course that is not listed in the structure.
- You have changed courses in a module that was approved before with different courses.
- You have added courses below a section where it says "not-graded".



If, according to the study guide, it is ok to include the course in the section, please use free edit mode to add the course and apply for approval on [page 19](#).

If you have changed the Courses, apply for approval again, [page 21](#).

4.2. Substitutions

Sisu PSP doesn't recognize substituting courses but you need to change the substituting course to the PSP by yourself.

These cases are:

- Courses completed in Aalto Open University that have a course code starting with the letter A.
- Course code or name have changed, but the new and old courses are similar in content.

5.1 Credit transfer – Inclusion and substitution
