# Funder requirements for OA and data management

## EC /H2020

**Participant portal – standard requirement in call text, e.g. ICT-01-2019: ”Open access must be granted to all scientific publications** resulting from Horizon 2020 actions.” Requirements, see Annotated Model Grant Agreement (AMGA) p. 246-7. For guidance, see online manual for open access and data management.

**AoF /September call appendix 3, similar to General conditions and guidelines for funding 2018–2019, pp. 22-23:**

”We require that Academy-funded projects commit to open access publishing”

- Article processing fees for **Gold OA** / **Hybrid OA** are eligible project costs
- **Green OA** / parallel publishing, 6/12 mth embargo allowed

**Business Finland, foundations, and other funding agencies** seldom have specific requirements, advice to follow best practices of EC and AoF.
