

AV touch panel UI

Quick guide

- 1 You can start the presentation using the short-cut buttons.

Choose Laptop or Wireless. All three projectors will automatically be switched on. The system starts and will automatically begin the presentation.



If you are using a source that does not have a short-cut button or want more control over the presentation, choose "Start system only".

Start system only

Closing the lock icon locks the current audio source so that it will not change even if the image source does. Opening the lock releases the audio to follow the current source.

Projectors of/off and video wall

- 2 Choose the source you want to use.

Be sure to switch on the external display of your PC. If you are presenting audio aswell and are using the HDMI you will have to choose the right audio output in the control panel of your PC.

- 3 Press the show button:

- 4 Stop the presentation by pressing the cross:

- 5 Switch off the system by pressing the 'off' button in the lower left corner when you finish the presentation.

You will also have to choose 'shutdown' when asked if you want to shut down the system. The AV equipment will then be switched off and the system resets.

The system will start automatic shutdown once no projector has been receiving signal for three minutes. The automatic shutdown has a timewindow of five minutes, during which you can cancel the shutdown process by choosing "Cancel" or by starting a presentation.
