

CEMS Master's in International Management (MIM) Add-on 'Crown' CEMS MIM

Application for academic year 2021-2022

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Formal entry requirements:

1. **Master's student at Aalto University** (Bachelor's degree obtained by August 1st 2021)
2. Must meet the **eligibility conditions for Master's level exchange studies** in the student's own Aalto school / MSc programme
3. **60 ECTS of business related studies:** BSc and MSc level studies combined, completed and on record by August 1st 2021
4. **Language requirements:** Proficiency in English and a second language (see below)

Proof of compliance with the criteria must be submitted with the application.

Language requirements:

Language 1: English

Proficiency in English is an entry requirement for the program. Acceptable proof for proficiency:

1. Mother tongue; *OR*
2. Bachelor's or Master's diploma from a programme entirely taught in English, in an English speaking country; *OR*
3. Bachelor's or Master's diploma from a programme entirely taught in English, in a CEMS or an EQUIS/AACSB accredited institution (e.g. Aalto - Mikkeli BScBA meets this requirement); *OR*
4. One of the following commercial exams (accepted level of proficiency indicated)
 - IELTS (7.0 or higher),
 - TOEFL (iBT100 or higher),
 - CAE ("A", "B"), BEC Higher ("A", "B") or CPE ("A", "B", "C")

The above listed minimum scores represent a C1 proficiency level in English, which CEMS considers valid for life. Thus, for CEMS MIM applications, an acceptable score does not 'expire' even when the testing service only gives it a limited validity period.

Note 1: current enrollment in an MSc programme taught in English is not sufficient proof of English proficiency. For option 2 above, the student must be able to provide a certificate of an already completed college / university degree.

Note 2: for option 4, you must submit either the copy of your English exam results or a confirmation of your registration to an English exam with your CEMS MIM application. The commercial English exam must take place before the assessment day January 28, 2021.

Language 2: any language

1. This requirement is fulfilled if your mother tongue is other than English.
2. If your only mother tongue is English, you must submit proof of proficiency at B1/B2 CEFR-level in a language other than English.
