	<p><b>1. I propose the permission for defence to be granted.</b>          The pre-examiner does not require any corrections and changes in the statement, but can make suggestions for improving the manuscript.</p>
	<p><b>2. I propose the permission for defence to be granted after minor revisions.</b>          Minor revisions may include the need for additional material acquired with moderate effort or the need for further inclusion of research literature. The supervising professor is responsible for ensuring that the revisions required are made.</p>
	<p><b>3. I propose major revisions to the manuscript.</b>          Substantial changes and corrections may include revisions of research design and the development of the argument. The manuscript needs to be pre-examined again by one or two pre-examiners before the decision about granting the permission for defence can be made.</p>
	<p><b>4. I propose that the permission for defence is denied.</b>          If the dissertation has serious deficiencies with the quality of research and/or research integrity, the pre-examiner must clearly indicate the deficiencies in the statement and recommend that the doctoral candidate be denied permission for public defence.</p>
