# BScBA: Study plan suddenly against the rules, what do I need to do?

Updated on 31 Aug, 2021: Information about having to add the courses again to your plan.

## What happened?

Most study plans (hops) based on the academic years 2020-2021 and earlier of the BScBA Programme are in **against the rules** state. In addition, this might affect some of the newer ones made before this news article was published. All plans created after the change are unaffected.

### What do I need to do?

If your plan was suddenly labeled being against the rules, please take the steps below to get rid of the error. If your situation differs from what is described below there is probably some other reason for the error.

#### The steps:


- 1. Click the programme level: Bachelor's Programme in International Business (BIZM1)
- If you had already selected or completed elective courses, please take notes of them. You'll have to add them your plan again later.
- 3. Click the thrash can icon next to the *Electives module (BIZM1.V)*


Take the next steps **only if** you had selected any elective courses before **or** at any point if you choose to add elective courses to your plan.

- 4. If not already chosen automatically, click to choose the new Electives section
- 5. Scroll down and click the new *Electives* section
- 6. Select the Electives module (BIZM1.V), and it appears on the left
- 7. Click the *Electives module (BIZM1.V)* to see its contents (it's the same module as before now in the wanted location).
- 8. If you had selected or completed elective courses, add them again here.
