Process to choose the MSc. Program

- Mikkeli students have the automatic study right to continue studies for the M.Sc. Degree at the Aalto BIZ Otaniemi Campus.
- You graduate from the BScBA Program first with the required 180 cr for the degree.
 - When you request for the BSc diploma, you also inform us in which MSc. Program you would like to continue in.
 - Mari checks that the student meets with the criteria and confirms the MSc. Program to the student + introduces the Planning Officer of the MSc. Program in question.
 - The study right for the MSc. Program will be opened when you graduate from the BScBA Program.
- All the questions and issues before graduating from the BScBA Program should be discussed with Mari.

Info on MSc. Programs

- Every MSc. Program has specific criteria for the Mikkeli graduates to continue studies in them. NOTE. Criteria differs from the criteria for the Otaniemi BSc. students.

- The studies described with each Master's Program need to be completed by the graduation from the Mikkeli BScBA Program and they need to included to the B.Sc. degree studies.

MSc. Programs with separate admission

- There are three MSc. Programs that require a separate admission process for all Aalto BIZ graduates:
 - Creative Sustainability
 - Global Management (incl. CEMS MIM)
 - International Design Business Management
- The application period for them is in Dec-Jan and the study right begins in August.
 - If you are accepted in one of them, it is wise to accept first another study place with the automatic study right if you graduate in the spring, to keep your Aalto account working + then give up that automatic study right when the new study right begins in August.

Tuition fees and scholarships

- Tuition-fee liable BSc. students who complete their BSc. degree in normative time
 (i.e. three years or six semesters) with a final GPA of 3.80 or above, will receive <u>upon application</u> a full, category A scholarship for their Aalto MSc. Program (with the automatic study right), covering 100% of their tuition fees for the normative duration of the master's program (i.e. two years or four semesters).
 - Scholarship (tuition fee waiver) application is part of the graduation request form.
- Please note that this scholarship does not cover those three MSc. programs that require a separate application in the Aalto Master's Admissions.
 - You need to apply for a new scholarship for them.
