1. The plagiarism spectrum & types

These types show how Turnitin can help thesis writers to identify various writing problems.

2. Turnitin as a diagnostic tool: avoid plagiarism and improve your style!

- Academic writing involves a balance between your own “voice” and the “voice” of others.
- A Turnitin similarity report can help you to see more clearly where you have stayed too close to original sources, eg due to not paraphrasing sufficiently.
- The similarity percentage doesn't tell the whole story. Is 30% too much? It depends.
- The report can help you check that you have put quotation marks/inverted commas around directly quoted text.

3. Project & time management

- Reminder: The Turnitin program allows you to re-submit texts (Sauli Hänninen will review the rules for resubmission).
- Set your own deadline for submitting a draft text at least 2-3 days before the regular deadline.
- **Sample scenarios**
 - **Plan A:** (less time for writing, plenty of time for editing)
 - *Submit draft literature review to Turnitin by Wednesday, January 18, get originality report. Scan immediately for problems.*
 - *Use the following week to fix any problems, track down missing references and work on paraphrasing. Make final edits.*
 - *Submit the lit review by Thursday, January 26.*
 - **Plan B:** (more time for writing, but only time for quick round of edits)
 - *Submit draft literature review to Turnitin by Sunday, January 22, get originality report. Scan immediately for problems.*
 - *Use the following days to fix any problems, track down missing references and work on paraphrasing. Make final edits.*
 - *Submit the lit review by Thursday, January 26.*

Project & time management (cont.)

Keep in mind:

- New this year: based on feedback from recent years, we move the lit review deadline up in order to allow more time for data-gathering.
- Nothing irritates a thesis supervisor more than getting an incomplete draft! (Well, maybe plagiarism. .)
- The more changes you must make after the first draft is done, the less time you have for other parts of the research.
- Enable your supervisor to focus on the content and not be distracted by other issues.
- Demonstrate professionalism in managing this project.
- Submit a complete and polished draft by January 26!
