





PREPARE YOURSELF

Focus on your CV

- Clear structure, readability, check spelling, concise format
- Photo?, aalto-email address, phone
- Tailor CV to fit the position →Add a summary about your skills and experience in the beginning of your CV
- Show your personality: who you are and what you have learned not only your technical skills



PREPARE YOURSELF

Update your LinkedIn profile

- Be visible, good profile creates interest
- Add relevant information about your experience, studies and skills (avoid generalizations, organization slang)
- If you have done any special projects or publications, add those to your profile (or a link to another page where those are presented)




PREPARE YOUR PITCH!

& your Cover Letter

- Have an idea about the area or field you would like to work in
- Know your skills, experience & motivation related to the job
- Make a list of your top companies and find out how you could help their business
 know your audience
- Be prepared to meet company representatives, understand their needs (business) and to present yourself in a professional manner
- Make sure your content is relevant, your language is clear, your delivery is well-paced, you don't include any unnecessary details and that you do all you can to connect with your audience.








Low hierarchy
